
**Contraceptive care provided to over 59,000 females prevented...**

- 16,140** unintended pregnancies
- 7,600** unplanned births 
- 5,460** abortions 
- 3,080** miscarriages following unintended pregnancies 

**Over 122,000 STI tests provided to males and females prevented...**

- 960** chlamydia infections 
- 150** gonorrhea infections 
- 20** infertility cases 

**Over 17,000 Pap and HPV tests provided to females prevented...**

- 10** cervical cancer cases  

## These investments in 2024 resulted in net government savings of **\$86,129,850.**
