Match Priority for Breastfeeding Participants and Infants p. 4	Procedure: B: Added B, 1 Note Cascades automatically matches the breastfeeding pair’s priority based on the risks selected.	
Changes in Priority During the Certification Period p. 5	Policy: Removed: Within a certification period, the client’s priority shall not be lowered, except to correct a mistake.	Staff can’t lower a participant’s priority after pressing the Certify button. Write a note in the participant’s file if there’s an error with the participant’s risk(s) or priority.
Bumping	Removed policy	Policy no longer needed. Washington WIC serves all priorities and ages.
Waiting Lists p. 8 - 10	Policy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removed references to bumping. • Aligned with Cascades. • Removed references to paper Waiting Lists. 	
Appendix	Removed Appendix	The Appendix had paper waiting lists. Waiting Lists are maintained in Cascades when needed.
