




### **Enter Medical Documentation for the First Time**


If a participant needs a MDF and <u>one already exists</u> for that participant, please use <u>Cascades Steps – Enter New Medical Documentation When</u> <u>Current Medical Documentation Exists</u>.

- Use these steps when a participant's medical provider prescribes medical foods or formulas.
- The process is the same for all participant categories and all foods and formulas prescribed by a medical provider.

















