
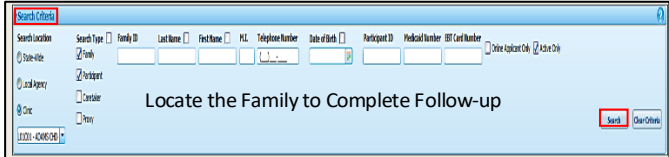
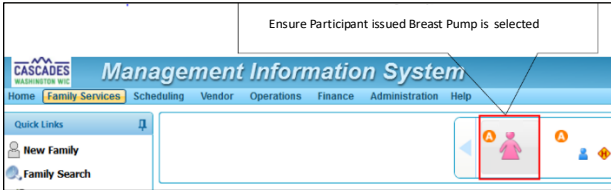
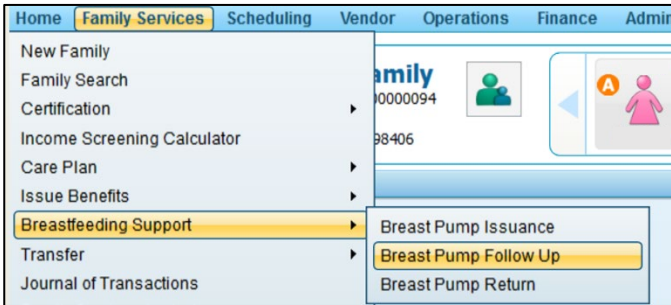


Note: The purpose of this steps sheet is to display how to document and complete a Multi User Breast Pump Follow Up using Cascades.

Steps	Cascades Screen
<p>Step 1 Family Search</p> <p>Using Family search</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Search Criteria displays • Search for participant under Search Criteria • Family Carousal displays • Ensure Participant issued pump is selected <p>Proceed to Step 2</p>	  
<p>Step 2: Breastfeeding Support Follow-up</p> <p>In order to access Breast Pump Follow Up select:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Family Services • Breastfeeding Support • Breast Pump Follow Up <p>Proceed to Step 3</p>

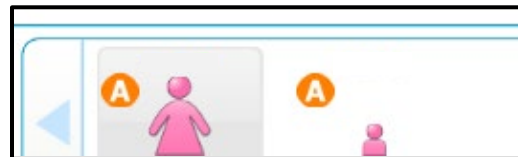
- Follow-Up Date can be changed
